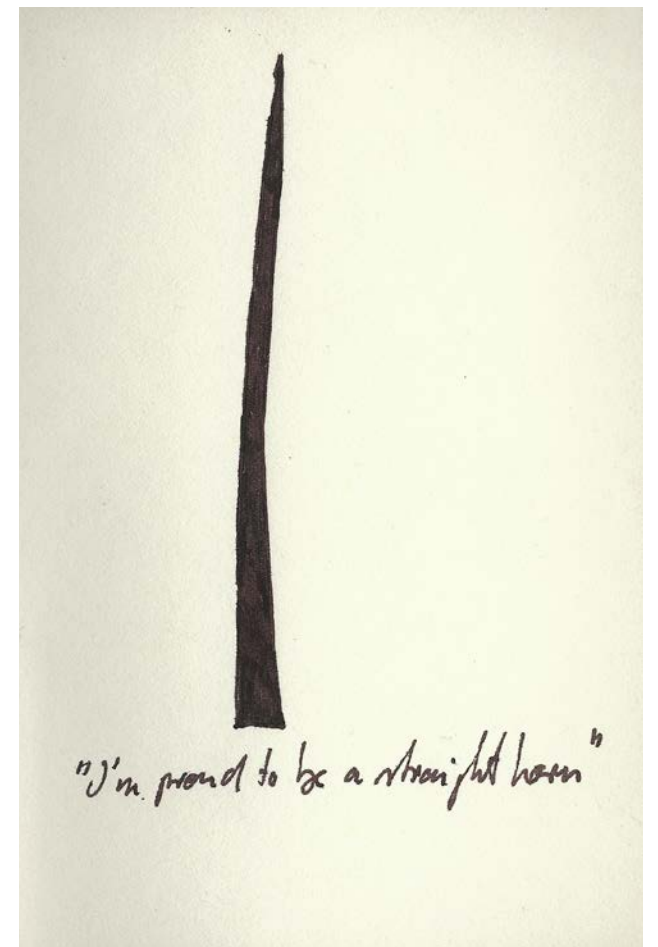
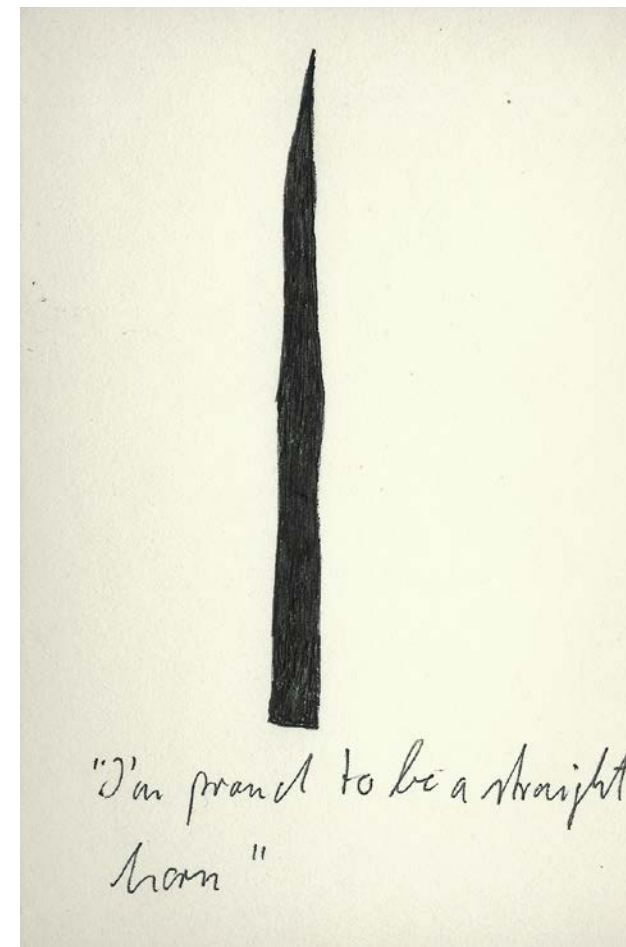


“ich bin stolz...” - “i’m proud...”

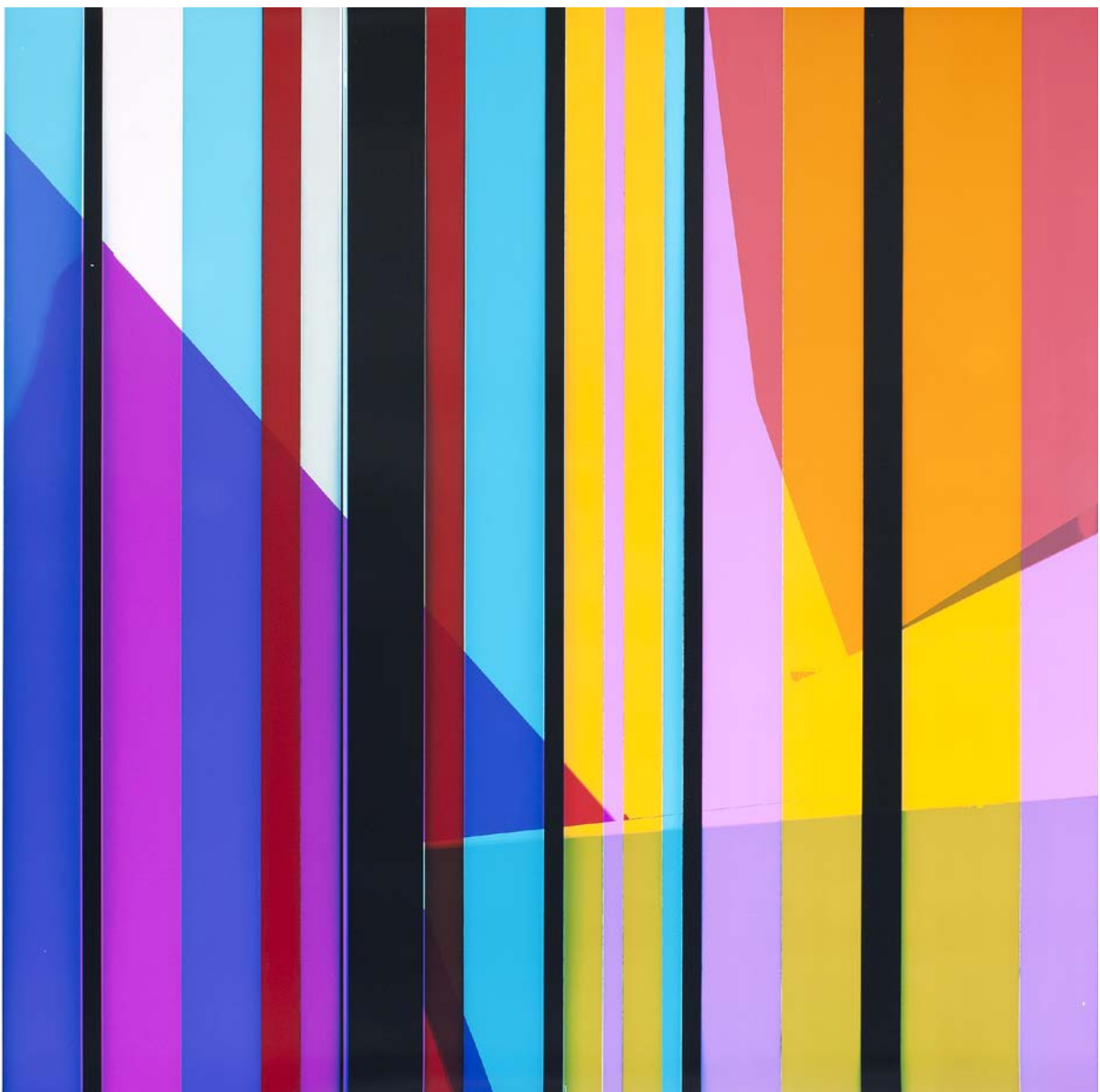

The sense of having?¹

While the individuum addicts oneself on the macro-level of the visible of consumption to the infinite desire-dialog of „having“ and „having-not“ and activates all resources at its disposal, prepared to the risk of indebtedness, to satisfy its own desires in the form of having consumer products (thereby allegedly through satisfying ones owns pleasures simultaneously taking care of the neighbours job and thereby doing good), - proceed these individual-desire-satisfaction-successes at the invisible micro-level of the financial capital in form of categorizing/classifying into the economical succesfull - class of „have“ and into the economical unsuccessful-class of „have-not“.

Is there not again a reproduction of Social - Darwinistic theories taking place, applied towards economical successful and economical unsuccessful individuals? Individuals, who are constantly competing with each other, where only the best, the economical fittest wins through?

„Have-not“ is not to be understood as a natural phenomenon, or as a result of a selection process for the economical fittest, but as a political phenomenon which references to economical relationships/conditions which are political in origin. It is „manmade“ not „naturemade“.

Will be now, in year seven since the beginning of the crisis, the lust-consumption-economy continued to be drained?

The „haves“ are removing their capital more and more from the economic cycle - they are giving away solely their debts?

The individual-lust-economy turns into an individual-debts-economy? – a reproduction of the christian concept of original sin? Into which one was thrown into, before one was born, and into which all future generations will be thrown into in form of the economical original sin? Which more and more tightens its chains? A „democracy in line with the market“, which expels those from their flats who cannot afford their rents anymore, because they are not economical successful in this neoliberal system and not belonging to the „haves“?

„Have“ and „Have-not“ – is this concept really the only possibility to separate the world into?

Are there not even in „the now“ different concepts existing, which one could remember? Like the gift economy, which is practised daily in the households or the administration/management of Allemenderesources which are not only private-organized or by the state, but polycentric and self-organized?²

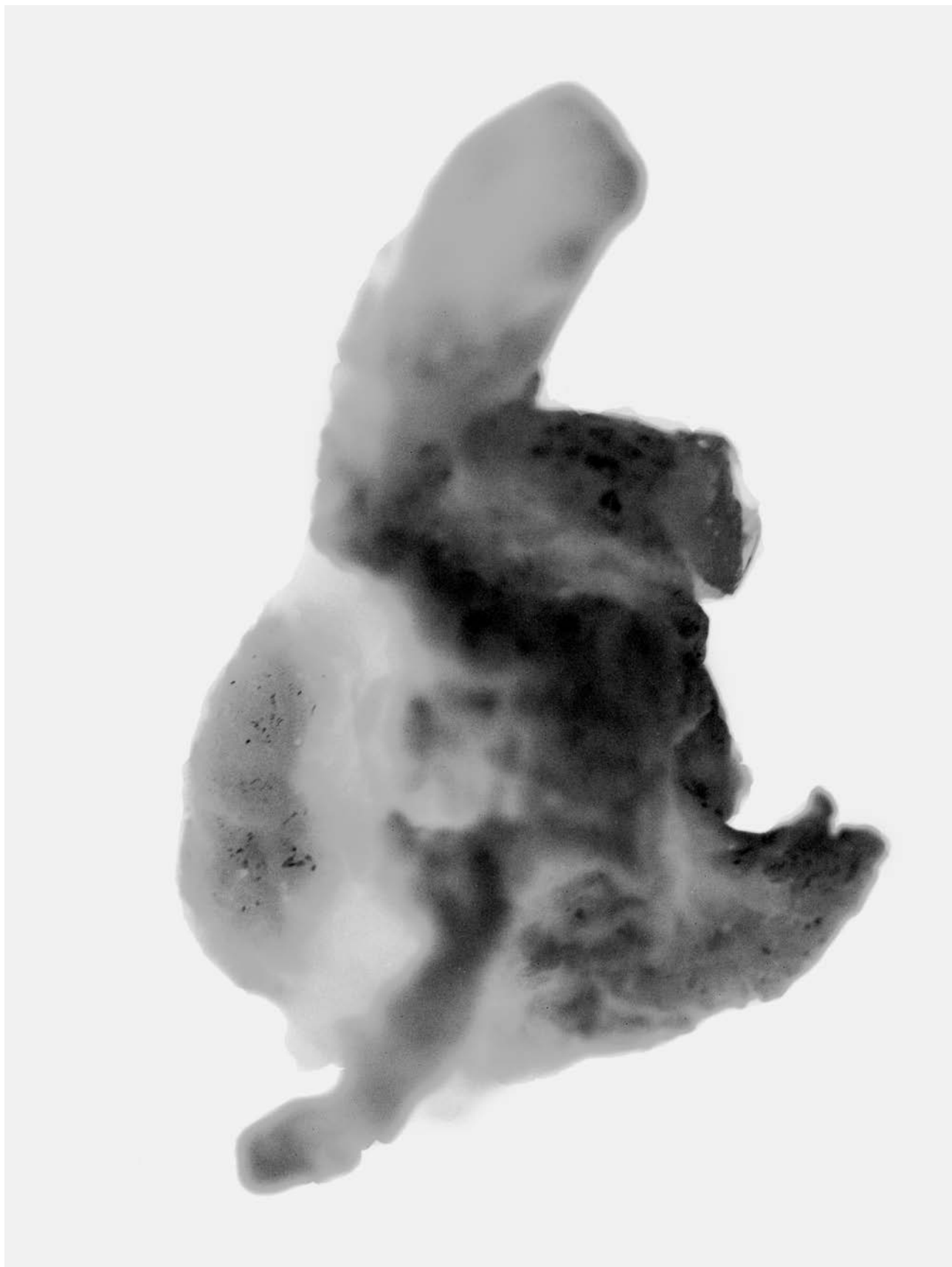

M - Plastic is a serial of different forms / plastics where milk (M) was used as sculptural material. The artists were forming this material and explored its inherent qualities. Every forming process led to a plastic - a M - Plastic - and is part of the serial. The form giving process (often spontaneous and insignificant / meaningless and vice versa) reveals the new Gestalt. The shape of the Gestalt is irrelevant. Some of the forms are simple, others are complex. Every M - Plastic is as important as each other M - Plastic and part of an ∞ - serial (as long as $M = \infty$). The presentation of the plastic as photography is equivalent to the plastic - no - it is the only contemporary presentation of M - Plastic in the 21 century. The size of each plastic is equivalent to the size of the respective photography. The size of each photography is equivalent to the size of the respective plastic. M - Plastic is the new contemporary sculpture.
